Dear Sir,

As discussed, with an attempt to create a group of trained professionals as support person for Ranchi and train the PLVS associated with CWC to provide the support to the child victim of crime (sexual abuse) as support person, two training programs have been planned from 11th to 14th December 2018.

As a step towards identifying the persons who can be further developed/capacitated as support persons, orientation program for about 65 PLVs, NGO representatives and others was organized jointly by DLSA Ranchi and UNICEF in partnership with ENFOLD (Bangalore based NGO working with Karnataka government on effective implementation of the provision of POCSO) on 10th October 2018. Based on the questionnaire filled by the participants, 35 persons from Ranchi district have been identified who can be further trained as support persons. The list is attached above for your reference.

Taking forward the task initiated on 10th October 2018, we plan to organize the trainings mentioned below in collaboration with JHALSA and with support from DLSA Ranchi and JSCPS.

- 1. Three days training of the selected persons identified from Ranchi districts to develop their capacities as support persons (list attached) from 11th to 13th December 2018.
- 2. One day training of two PLVs associated with Child Welfare Committee of remaining 23 districts (except Ranchi) on how to work as support persons is planned on 14th December 2018

We request your support to provide the conference hall of JHALSA along with laptop projector, mikes etc for four days (i.e from 11th to 14th December) and travel reimbursement of PLVs attending the program. Resource persons travel and fees, food for participants and training kit will be supported by ENFOLD with UNICEF fund.

Requesting your presence in the inaugural session on 11th and 14th December for guidance and motivation to the participants.

Looking forward for your support as always. Will share the training schedule soon.
