> Opening of Current Account for State Legal Aid Fund, District Legal Aid Fund and Account of grant received by the HCLSC.

Sir.

I am directed to state that, the Government of India has introduced a new Sub-Rule 230(8) in the General Financial Rules (GFR), 2017 Edition according to which all the interests or other earnings against Grants in Aid released to any grantee institution should be mandatorily remitted to the Consolidated Fund of India immediately after finalization of account. Such interests should not be allowed to be adjusted against future releases.

- The issue has been examined in NALSA and it is observed that the deposits in the National Legal Aid Fund, State Legal Aid Fund and the District Legal Aid Fund consist of grants-in-aid received from Central Authority/State Authority, any grants or donations made to the Authority by any person, State Authority and any other amount received under the order of the Courts under the provision of Sections 15, 16 & 17 of the Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987. Therefore, it may be very difficult to quantify the interest earned on the grant received from the Central Government by these Authorities during a Financial Year to deposit the prorata interest in the Consolidated Fund of India under the provision of GFR, 230(8).
- In view of this, it has been decided with the approval of Hon'ble Executive Chairman, NALSA that the accounts of National Legal Aid Fund, State Legal Aid Fund, District Legal Aid Fund & Accounts of High Court Legal Services Committee receiving Central grant from the State Authorities may be converted into current account if these are in Savings Bank Account. All the State Legal Services Authorities are therefore requested to take urgent action and convert the account of State Legal Aid Fund into a Current Account positively by 31st October, 2018. The State Legal Services Authorities are also advised to intimate all District Legal Services Authorities and High Court Legal Services Committees to take similar action by 31st October, 2018.
