Sir/Madam,

National Green Tribunal established under the NGT Act, 2010, provides a forum for relief and compensation to the victims of pollution and environment damage. The NGT has Benches only at five places in the country. It becomes difficult for people living in far off places to access NGT and its Benches due to geographical distances.


2. National Green Tribunal has recently started online remedy / petition. People can avail online without going to the places where NGT and its Benches are located. In this regard, Hon'ble Chairperson, National Green Tribunal requested NALSA to apprise the masses about the availability of the said service and also assist the needy and eligible persons to avail their online remedy/petition to promote the Access to Justice for all.

3. In view of the above, it is requested that all State Legal Services Authorities take the following steps:

- (i) In their ongoing awareness programmes/camps, disseminate information about online mechanism/remedy of approaching NGT with regard to matters related to relief and compensation to the victim of pollution and environment damage;
- (ii) Apprise panel advocates and PLVs about the same so that they assist needy and eligible persons in filing such online applications in appropriate cases.
- (iii) Upload the information of website on SLSAs about availability of facility with web address of NGT i.e. greentribunal.gov.in.
