Sub: Report in connection with action taken in view of News item published in daily Hindi Newspaper "Hindustan" dated 21.11.2015 regarding trafficking of two adolescent schoolgirls.


Sir,

With reference to the subject noted above the undersigned took immediate steps and directed the Secretary, DLSA, Chatra, vide letter no 1086/2015 dated 21.11.2015 to take immediate steps from the ends of DLSA, Chatra, to prevent such trafficking under the pretext of marriage and to provide legal aid to adolescent schoolgirls.

The Secretary, DLSA, Chatra, has intimated vide letter no. 1632 dated 21.11.2015 that he has directed the C.W.C., Chatra and the concerned PLV namely Shri Chintamani Pathak to verify and enquire into the matter and also to provide legal aid and therefore to submit their respective reports. He has also reported that Sri Chintamani Pathak, PLV immediately reached at the house of minor girls and provided legal aid to them with cooperation of civil as well police administration and due to legal aid provided by D.L.S.A, Chatra, the trafficking of adolescent school girls has been prevented with an timely intervention of local police as per direction of the District Legal Services Authority, Chatra. The concerned newspaper cutting is being annexed herewith for kind perusal. The further development in this regard will also be intimated to the Hon'ble JHALSA for needful.
